Listening with the Spirit

is a two year formation/discernment process.

In the context of community, participants are invited to explore and develop attitudes and skills appropriate for those called to the adventure of serving as a spiritual companion.

Class is limited to 18 participants.

Formation Process

First Year

The first year includes:

- A variety of approaches to spirituality and prayer
- Faith-sharing, group spiritual direction
- Integration of psychology and spirituality within the ministry of spiritual direction
- Skills needed for the art of direction
- Ongoing discernment for the ministry
- Language for understanding and expressing the inner journey

Second Year

The second year is a year of experience in Spiritual Direction which includes:

- Topical presentations relating to direction and spiritual growth
- Supervised experience of spiritual direction
- Experience of individual and peer group supervision
- On-going discernment for the ministry

Meeting Time

Class meets Monday afternoon from 1-4 pm, beginning September 24, 2007 through May 5, 2008. There will be no class on the Sisters' silence day which is usually the second Monday of the month.

Admission Criteria

The program is ecumenical in character and is open to people of who are:

Prayerful persons able to listen to God, self and others

Grounded in a faith tradition

Able to demonstrate basic competencies in contemporary scripture, theology and psychology

In a spiritual direction relationship with someone trained in spiritual direction

Has made a silent retreat

Able to articulate a sense of call to this ministry

Available for an interview with the program staff
